## NEW PATIENT CONSULTATION

Initial visit with physician or physician assistant (PA), includes:

### Vascular ultrasound

Identify the source of vein disease through non-invasive imaging

### Discuss ultrasound results

- Personalized treatment plan
- If necessary, initiate conservative therapy for 90 days

### Insurance approval

Can take 30-90 days for insurance approval after conservative therapy.
